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#### History

- Evaluated in the Pediatric Emergency Dept. for a swollen arm with a small bruise.
- Noted by mother when she returned from work at about 10 PM.
- Baby in care of babysitter, mother's partner and partner's mother during evening.
- May have injured arm taking her out of car seat.
- "Fussy" all evening, but not unusual for this baby.



## Key Points

- Humerus fractures in infants should trigger concern for abuse.
- Bruises in infants should trigger concern for abuse.
- Evaluation for abuse in an infant should include a skeletal survey, eye exam and head imaging study.
